As Chief Operating Officer of BryceTech, Brigadier General (Ret.) Ian Dickinson leads day-to-day operations, facilities, security and infrastructure. Gen. Dickinson has served as a leader in cyberspace for military and Government organizations for over 20 years. He managed, maintained, and secured the cyberspace domain used by the Air Force, and he trained warfighters to fight in and protect that domain. He served as Deputy Chief Information Officer of the Joint Staff, ran regional communications for task forces in combat, and oversaw the creation of the first undergraduate cyber training curriculum for Air Force personnel.
